



Poker Run Rules



BOYS & GIRLS CLUB

A punch card is a minimum \$15.00 donation. At the starting point (Boys & Girls Club) buy as many punch cards as you want. Once you've purchased your punch card(s), you have the option to draw all your cards to see your hand (Separate draw per punch card). If you get all of your punches and you don't like your hand, you can buy wild cards for \$2.00 each to better your hand. **A wild card is an additional card drawn from the deck used to better your hand.** (You must choose which punch card the wild card is to be used for, prior to drawing.) Once you've completed all your draws, you can do as you wish until the "Best Hand Drawing" at Flyers, OR you can get one punch and ride to the other punch card locations to draw for the remaining punches.
